<b>A</b>	Wheelchair <b>Accessible</b>	<b>L</b>	Meeting where AA <b>Literature</b> is available for sale
<b>ABSI</b>	Group reads and discusses a page from the book <b>As Bill Sees It</b>	<b>LS</b>	Group reads and discusses the day's topic from the book <b>Living Sober</b>
<b>B</b>	<b>Beginner's Meeting</b> - NOT for beginner's only, but usually concentrating on the first 3 Steps.	<b>M</b>	A meeting that discusses <b>Men's</b> issues as related to their alcoholism
<b>BB</b>	Group reads and discusses the <b>Big Book</b>	<b>MED</b>	A meeting usually based on the 11th Step is a <b>Meditation</b> meeting
<b>C</b>	<b>Closed</b> Meeting - For alcoholics only. Tradition 3 states the only requirement for membership is a desire to stop drinking	<b>O</b>	<b>Open</b> meeting can be attended by alcoholics, their friends, family, or anyone interested in AA
<b>CC</b>	<b>Child Care</b> available	<b>P</b>	Meeting based on the <b>Promises</b> of AA
<b>CF</b>	Meetings held in a <b>Correctional Facility</b>	<b>S</b>	Meeting where <b>Smoking</b> is permitted
<b>CR</b>	Meeting in a correctional facility that has <b>Clearance Required</b>	<b>SL</b>	A meeting which discusses AA's <b>Slogans</b>
<b>D</b>	Meeting for <b>Discussion</b> on anything alcohol related	<b>SP</b>	A meeting with one or more alcoholics sharing what it was like, what happened and what it is like now is a <b>Speaker</b> Meeting
<b>DR</b>	Group reads and discusses the day's topic from the book <b>Daily Reflections</b>	<b>SPAN</b>	<b>Spanish</b> speaking meeting
<b>E</b>	<b>English</b> Speaking - for our meetings near the Canadian border and in Canada	<b>STEP</b>	Group reads and discusses AA's <b>12 Steps</b>
<b>ESH</b>	A meeting that reads and discusses a story from the book <b>Experience, Strength &amp; Hope</b>	<b>T</b>	Usually a discussion meeting where after a person shares they " <b>Tag</b> " the next person to speak
<b>F</b>	<b>French</b> Speaking - for our meetings near the Canadian border and in Canada	<b>TP</b>	A discussion meeting based on an alcohol related <b>Topic</b>
<b>F/E</b>	<b>French and English</b>	<b>TR</b>	Group reads and discusses AA's <b>12 Traditions</b>
<b>G</b>	A meeting that discusses <b>Gay/Lesbian</b> issues as related to their alcoholism	<b>W</b>	A meeting that discusses <b>Women's</b> issues as related to their alcoholism
<b>GV</b>	Group reads and discusses an article from the <b>Grapevine</b> publication
