| BB | Group reads and discusses the Big Book | MED | A meeting usually based on the 11th Step is a Meditation meeting |
| C | Closed Meeting - For alcoholics only. Tradition 3 states the only requirement for membership is a desire to stop drinking | O | Open meeting can be attended by alcoholics, their friends, family, or anyone interested in AA |
| CC | Child Care available | P | Meeting based on the Promises of AA |
| CF | Meetings held in a Correctional Facility | S | Meeting where Smoking is permitted |
| CR | Meeting in a correctional facility that has Clearance Required | SL | A meeting which discusses AA's Slogans |
| D | Meeting for Discussion on anything alcohol related | SP | A meeting with one or more alcoholics sharing what it was like, what happened and what it is like now is a Speaker Meeting |
| DR | Group reads and discusses the day's topic from the book Daily Reflections | SPAN | Spanish speaking meeting |
| E | English Speaking - for our meetings near the Canadian border and in Canada | STEP | Group reads and discusses AA's 12 Steps |
| ESH | A meeting that reads and discusses a story from the book Experience, Strength & Hope | T | Usually a discussion meeting where after a person shares they " Tag " the next person to speak |
| F | French Speaking - for our meetings near the Canadian border and in Canada | TP | A discussion meeting based on an alcohol related Topic |
| F/E | French and English | TR | Group reads and discusses AA's 12 Traditions |
| G | A meeting that discusses Gay/Lesbian issues as related to their alcoholism | W | A meeting that discusses Women's issues as related to their alcoholism |
