C	Closed Meeting - For alcoholics only. Tradition 3 states the only requirement for membership is a desire to stop drinking	O	Open meeting can be attended by alcoholics, their friends, family, or anyone interested in AA
CC	Child Care available	P	Meeting based on the Promises of AA
CF	Meetings held in a Correctional Facility	S	Meeting where Smoking is permitted
CR	Meeting in a correctional facility that has Clearance Required	SL	A meeting which discusses AA's Slogans
D	Meeting for Discussion on anything alcohol related	SP	A meeting with one or more alcoholics sharing what it was like, what happened and what it is like now is a Speaker Meeting

E	English Speaking - for our meetings near the Canadian border and in Canada	STEP	Group reads and discusses AA's 12 Steps
